Working principally at the Halifax Infirmary site of the Queen Elizabeth II Health Sciences Centre, this position will also provide cover-off for the part-time Chaplain who serves the QEII Victoria General site, the Nova Scotia Rehabilitation and Arthritis Centre and the IWK Health Centre.

## The Position:

- The Chaplain will provide spiritual and religious care to Baptist patients, families and staff at Halifax hospitals in the context of the Discipline of Spiritual Care, working in a diverse environment with Chaplains of other denominations
- Full-time: 37.5 hours per week, with some flexibility in scheduling and some "on-call" shifts
- Salaried Position, with benefit package
- Starting date negotiable, between April 1 and June 1, 2022

## The Successful Candidate will be:

- A graduate of an accredited university with a Master of Divinity from an accredited theological school or acceptable equivalent advanced degree. Preference will be given to an ordained Baptist minister in good standing with the Convention of Atlantic Baptist Churches or other Baptist denominational body
- A holder of at least two units of Basic training or one unit of Advanced training toward certification by the Association for Spiritual Care (CASC), and willing to continue training toward full certification.
- An active member of the Canadian Association for Spiritual Care (CASC), or eligible for membership and willing to join before starting the position

## Preference will be given to Candidates with:

- Three or more years of Pastoral experience
- Chaplaincy experience in a hospital setting
- A CASC Certified Specialist qualification
