Keeping the Faith: Essays in Memory of Roger H. Prentice

The Rev. Dr. Roger Prentice was member of Wolfville Baptist Church. He died suddenly last spring. A chaplain in Acadia University from 1985 to 2007, Roger is sorely missed by many friends in Canada and across the world. Roger would have had his 80th birthday this summer and unbeknown to him, before his death some of Roger's friends were already working on essays for a *Festschrift* to mark the occasion. At his death, all of the contributors to the volume felt that it would be fitting to make the book a memorial volume.
